### Tournament points are as follows:

Win = 3 points

Loss = 0 points

Shutout = 2 points

Goals scored - up to 3 points max [i.e. if score 3 goals or 7 goals, max points still = 3; therefore, do NOT run up the score]

If two or three teams in a bracket have the same number of points, the tie breakers are:

First tie-breaker: winner of head-to-head game (skip to #2 if 3 or more teams are tied)

Second tie-breaker: Winner of most games

Third tie-breaker: Fewest goals allowed

Forth tie-breaker: Most goals scored - up to 3 per match

Fifth tie-breaker: Coin Toss

Directions to Sheridan Fields:  
(NOT the same as regular season)

From Indianapolis, take US 31 North to St Rd 38.  
Take 38 West to Sheridan (approx 5 miles)  
Follow 38 thru town and turn Right on 4th Street.  
4th Street will "T" into the south end of the soccer field.  
The field is behind Adams Elementary School  
(Old 3 story brick school) which is the Varsity Soccer Field.

The 7:00 games will be played under lights on the field.

Wild Card team is the 2nd place pool team.

### Shoot Out Rules for Pool Play and Championship Matches:

In the event of a tie, all players on the field at the end of the game must report to the center circle immediately. Do not let players go to sidelines!

Only players on the field at the end of the game are eligible to participate in the shoot out.

5 players, on each team, will alternate shots from a designated mark on the field. Each team will choose a goalie from the players on the field.

If a tie still stands, the procedure is repeated except, it then becomes sudden death. In the first round one teams scores and the other doesn't, the game is over.
